Uniform Policy

1. Correct uniform must be worn at all times during the day and when travelling to and from the Academy. Uniform must also be worn for educational visits unless otherwise instructed by the trip leader.
2. Students who do not have the complete or correct uniform must provide their Tutor with a note from a parent/carer explaining the reason why. If this is likely to extend beyond a day then their Head of Year must be provided with a note explaining the reason and when this will be rectified. Sanctions will be issued to students who flout expectations.
3. The same Academy uniform policy applies equally to all pupils however, the Academy will consider reasonable requests to alter the Academy uniform. Requests must be referred to the Headteacher, whose decision will be final.

- Black blazer with Academy logo
- Grey v-neck jumper with Academy logo, optional
- Clip on tie in Academy colour with Academy logo
- White shirt/Blouse – with top button for tie
- Black trousers - formal design from Academy preferred supplier
- Mid thigh length black skirt with Academy logo from Academy supplier
- Black tights/socks
- Plain black, polishable footwear/shoes (not trainers, trainer shoes, boots or canvas shoes)
- Coat appropriate for Academy - no hoodies.

SPORTS UNIFORM

- Rugby sports top in Academy colours with Academy logo
- Sports polo top in Academy colours with Academy logo
- Black sports shorts, Black skirt/skort with Academy logo
- Pair of Academy rugby/football/Hockey socks
- Pair of white sports socks
- Sports trainers/running shoes with non-marking sole
- Football/Rugby boots
- Plain black jogging bottoms with Academy logo for outside use, optional
- Sports fleece top in Academy colours with Academy logo for outside use, optional
- Parker PE Hooded jumper.

Additional Uniform Information

- Ear Piercings must be stud jewellery only in the lower lobe, no hooped earrings
- Subtle make up to be worn only.
- Natural Hair colours only
- Nose studs are not permitted unless a clear retainer
- No false/acrylic nails or nail varnish

All students must bring their PE Kit to extra-curricular clubs in a bag, changing facilities are available,. All piercings must be removed for PE lessons for health and safety.

We have as an Academy consulted our students, parents/guardians and staff regarding students wearing their PE kit on days where they have a formal PE lesson. The feedback was analysed and for the first term (September to December 2021) this was agreed. If students have an extra-curricular sports club on a day where they do not have a formal PE lesson they must wear their full correct school uniform and bring their PE kit in a bag to change into after school.

This arrangement will be review at the end of the first term and we will make an informed decision as to the arrangements for the second term (January to March 2022). We will inform you of the decision made.
